





#### **Active Learning Experiences**

- 91.0% of seniors spent at least 6 hours per week preparing for class
- 20.0% of seniors worked on a research project with a faculty member
- 53.0% of seniors participated in an internship, practicum, or field experience
- 71.0% of seniors participated in community service or volunteer work
- · 22.0% of seniors participated in study abroad
- 99.0% of seniors made at least one class presentation last year


#### FUTURE PLANS OF BACHELOR'S DEGREE RECIPIENTS


